The inhabitants of Dobeles County have always taken pride in having the most fertile agricultural land, the most productive wheat fields and the most abundant fruit gardens. Here, in the south of Latvia, the sun shines more generously than elsewhere in the country.

Situated at the south-west of the country, where the fertile plains of Zemgale meet the rolling hills of Kurzeme, the county is predominantly occupied by agricultural land – one of the most valuable and best cultivated in Latvia. Lilac trees burst into bloom, and fruit and grain ripen under a clear blue sky in Dobeles. The sun-kissed county can also boast of a bustling economic and cultural life.

Unique tourist attractions, natural diversity and rural goodies – available only 70 km from Riga. You have to see and experience it for yourself!

- The most mysterious site in Latvia – Pokaiņi Forest;
- Egons Tones collection of orchids at Apgulde – the biggest in Latvia;
- The mitten tree at the farm “Lejnieki” – the biggest single collection of knit mittens;
- “Pikšas” – the Memorial Museum of Kārlis Ulmanis in Bērze County on a modern Zemgalian farm dating back to the 1930s;
- The renovated Īle National Partisans’ Bunker – the biggest in the Baltics;
- Lake Zebrus – the most legendary lake in Zemgale and a fishermen’s paradise;
- The farm “Rūķīši” in Krīvas County – the biggest grower of medicinal herbs and producer of herbal tea in Latvia;
- Bērze Water Mill – the oldest water mill in Latvia still in operation.

- In honour of the 100th anniversary of Latvia, a 100m long scarf is being knit;
- Dobele meteorite impact crater – one of the largest in Europe.



Dobele – the Town of the Sun and Lilacs

The inhabitants of Dobele like awarding their town impressive titles, and why not if this sun-basked town of Zemgale can offer such a great deal of unique attractions? A lilac sanctuary in spring. A town of magnificent decorative gardens in summer. The capital of apples in autumn. The meeting place of giant snowmen in winter. And, last but not least, Dobele also holds a meteorite mystery as, allegedly, half a billion years ago one of the largest meteorites that hit Europe landed here.

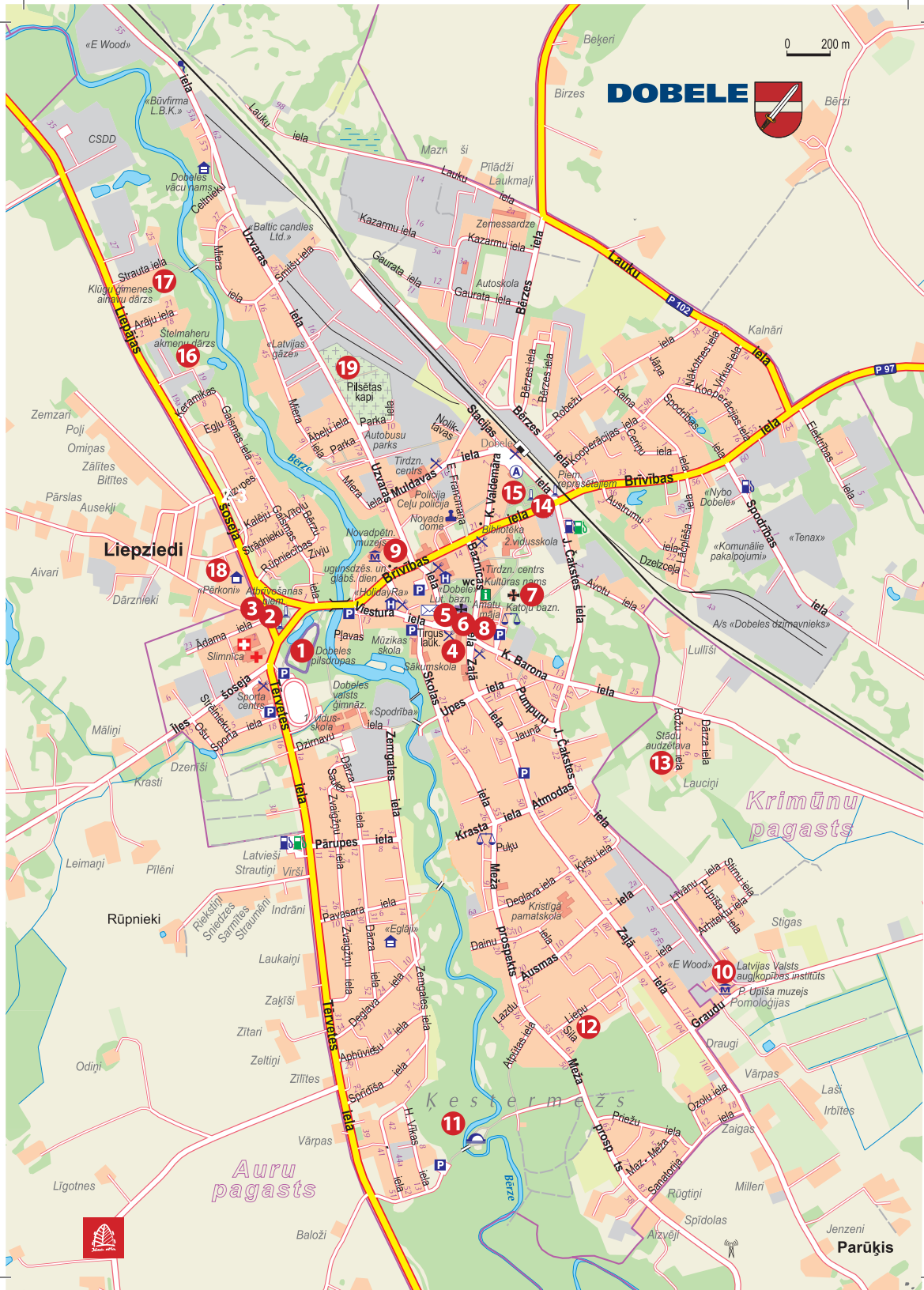
Dobele is one of the oldest settlement areas in Latvia, which developed by the picturesque Bērze River 760 years ago. Until the 12th century, this area was populated by Zemgalian tribes that had formed several administrative political centres here, Dobele being among the most important.

1. The ruins of the Livonian Order Castle

The picturesque castle ruins by Bērze River are still impressive. From 1335 to 1347, the Livonian Order built their stone castle on the site of the burnt down Zemgalian wooden castle. At present, the ruins are the oldest stone building in Dobeles and a cultural monument of national significance. The conservation works of the ruins were started in 2002. The observation deck in the renovated tower offers a great view of the town across Bērze River. You can have a guided tour around the castle by an entertaining castle lady. The walkway along the right bank of the Bērze River has become a favourite recreational site.

2. Dobeles Liberation Monument

This liberation monument designed by the distinguished sculptor Kārlis Zemdega has had a tragic fate. It was revealed for the first time in 1940 and destroyed 10 years later on the order of the Soviet authorities. The monument was renovated thanks to donations from the locals and was unveiled for a second time in 1996.

3. Memorial stone commemorating the departure of the Zemgalians from Dobeles

It commemorates the Zemgalian tribes, which in 1289, after fierce fights with the Livonian Order, burnt down their wooden castle and left Dobeles for Lithuania undefeated. The author – Mārtiņš Zauris.

4. The Marketplace – the Historical Centre of Dobele

Nowadays, the spacious marketplace is the heart of the town, where a variety of events take place. After the reconstruction, the marketplace has acquired cobblestones and a fountain shaped as a giant well.

The square developed alongside the construction of the church in the late 15th century. It is still encircled by two-storey brick buildings constructed in the 20th century, where wealthy landlords established their shops and hotels. The historical Latvian Society House, built in 1939 after the design of architect Pauls Kundziņš, now serves as Dobele Cultural Centre and Tourist Information Centre.

5. Dobele Evangelic Lutheran Church

The main vertical line in Dobele's skyline is the 45 m high church bell-tower. The white church was built in 1495 and has been reconstructed several times since then. The church houses a number of unique art monuments.

6. The Memorial for Augusts Bīlenšteins

The monument unveiled in the garden of Dobele Evangelic Lutheran church is dedicated to Augusts Bīlenšteins (1826 – 1907), a pastor of a German parish and an outstanding researcher of the Latvian language and ethnography. For almost 40 years, he served as a pastor of the German parish of Dobele.

7. Dobele Catholic All-Saint Trinity Church

Constructed in 2003, the church attracts attention with its modern architectural design.

8. Dobele Crafts House

10. The Garden and the museum of plant breeder Pēteris Upītis

Did you know that Dobele is dubbed the Metropolis of Lilacs? In late May, more than 200 species and hybrids of fragrant lilacs burst into bloom in the lilac garden exceeding 4 hectares.

The classical music concerts among blossoming lilacs have become an established tradition.

When the plant breeder Pēteris Upītis started a garden in the outskirts of sunny Dobele in 1957, he dreamed of turning the whole of Latvia into a blooming garden. His efforts are now successfully continued by the scientists of the Horticulture Institute. The garden of 45 hectares contains more than 5,000 species and hybrids of fruit plant crops. Tasting and gathering sweet cherries in early July as well as the Apple Festival in early October are genuinely mouth-watering events. However, the garden is available for tours all-year-around. P. Upītis' Memorial Museum provides an insight into his work and personality.

11. Ķestermežs

14. Memorial to the victims of the Communist genocide

The Memorial ensemble near the Dobeles railway station is dedicated to the victims of the Communist Genocide of 1941 and 1949. Over 100 m in length, it stretches in parallel to the railway tracks. It is the largest memorial place in Latvia for the politically repressed.

15. The Warriors' Cemetery Monument

The monument depicting a grieving soldier and a partisan was erected in 1956 in the World War II soldiers' cemetery at the base of the destroyed Dobeles Liberation Monument. It was created by Valdis Albergis, Ļevs Bukovskis and Alberts Terpilovskis.

16. The Štelmaheri Family Garden of Stones

The garden, created by Lilija and Alfrēds Štelmaheri, is called the Stone Fairytale, or the Miracle Garden. The wide array of stones has been collected over 30 years. The compositions of flowers and shrubs complete the exhibition of stones.

19. Memorial sites at the Dobeļe Cemetery

The cemetery developed in the 19th century as the cemetery of the Latvian and German parish. In 1939, a monument was unveiled here in memory of soldiers killed in World War I and Latvian Liberation Battles. Pastor Augusts Bilenšteins, poet Veronika Strēlerte, who passed away in Sweden in 1995, and the distinguished teacher, psychologist and philosopher Augusts Students are buried in this cemetery.

Discover the vicinity of Dobele

1. Lake Gaurata

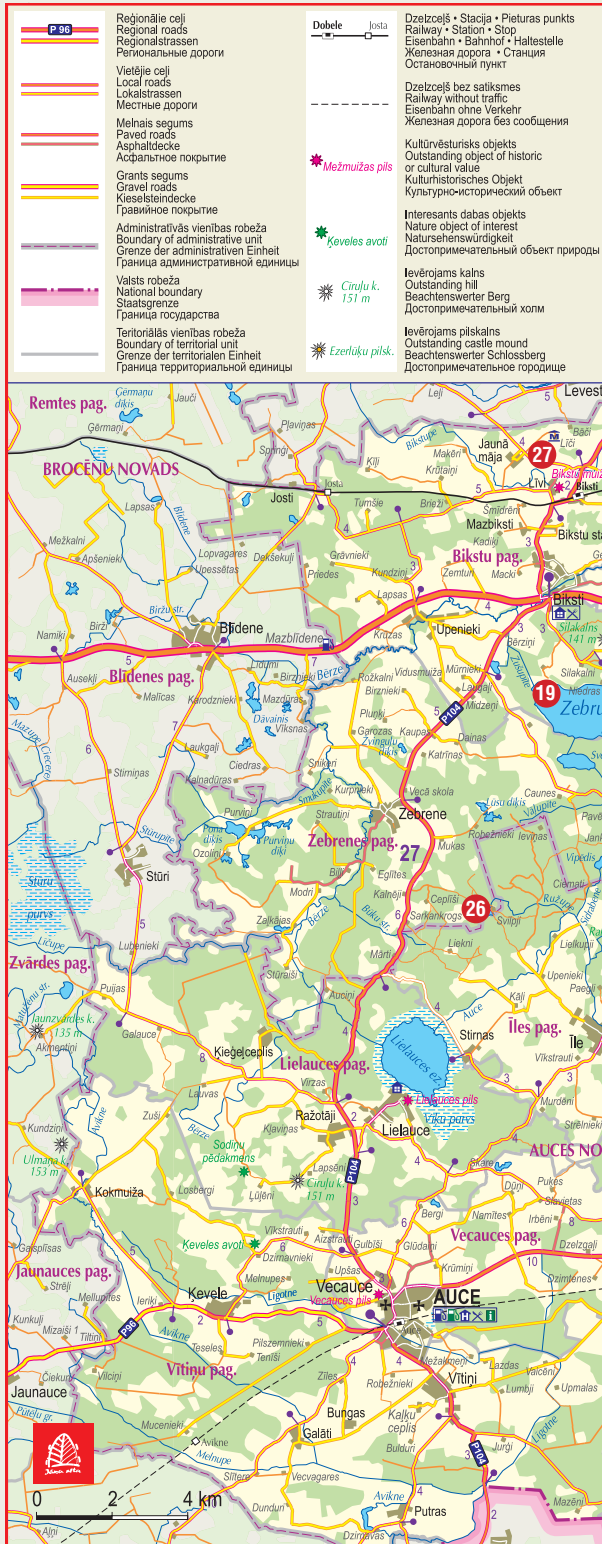

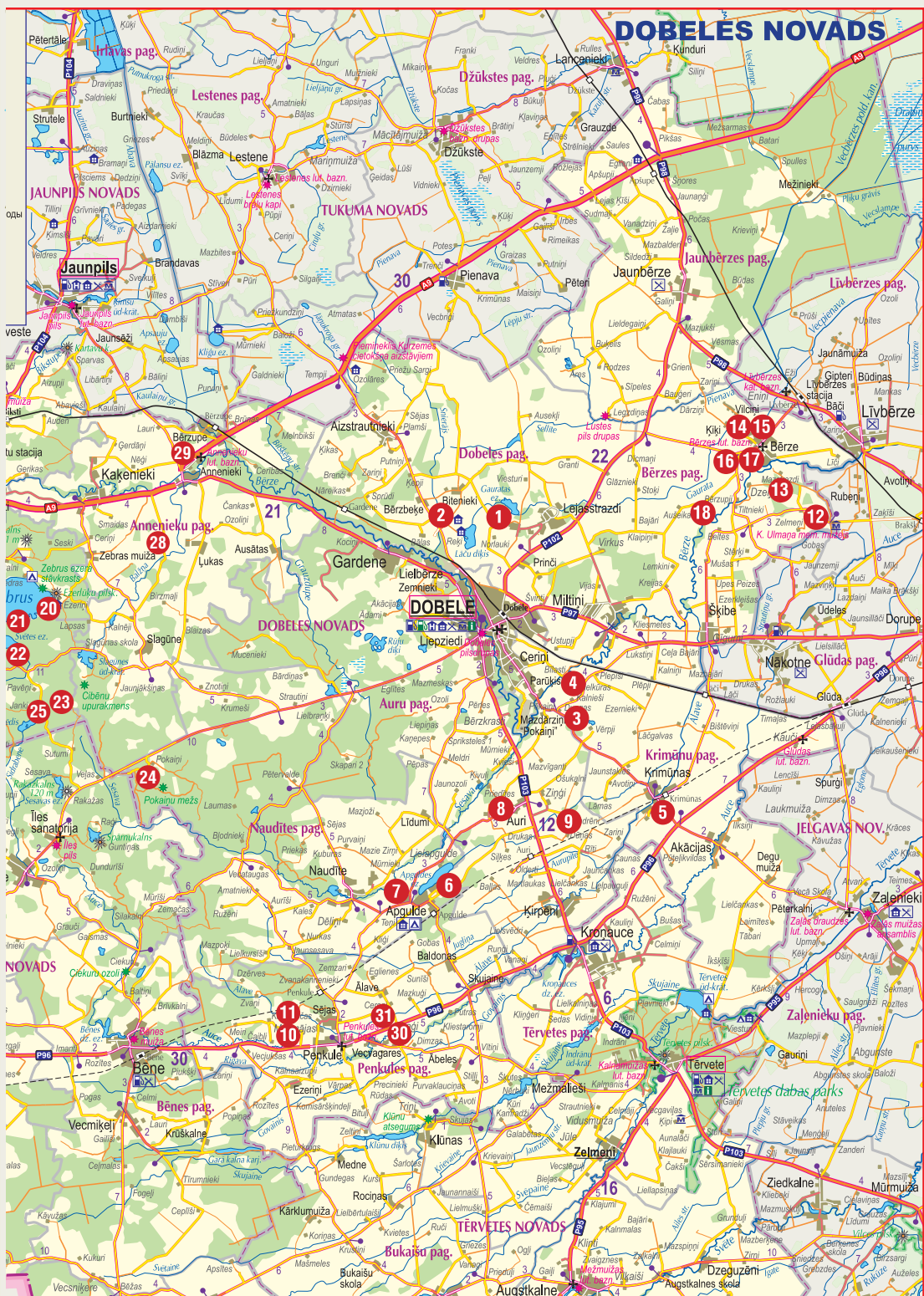
11. The Environmentally-Friendly Farm “Vizbuli”

Explore the birth-place of Kārlis Ulmanis

Kārlis Ulmanis – a co-founder of the State of Latvia, its first Prime Minister and the fourth President of the Republic of Latvia (1877-1942) – was born in Bērze County. During your visit of his birth-place, you will encounter the affluent, fertile Zemgalian farms, historic sites and hard-working people.

12. “Pikšas” - the Museum of Kārlis Ulmanis

Established in the renovated home of Kārlis Ulmanis, a co-founder of the State of Latvia, the museum represents a stately, modern and well-tended Zemgalian farm of the 1930s. “Pikšas” has become one of the most prominent cultural and historic monuments in Latvia. The exhibition in the dwelling house is dedicated to K. Ulmanis’ life and political activities. Other renovated buildings host permanent exhibitions of agricultural machinery and paintings.

14. Bērze Lutheran Church

Bērze Lutheran Church was rebuilt in its present form in the mid-19th century. Kārlis Ulmanis was baptised and confirmed here. The bell presented to the church by a co-founder of the State of Latvia still summons worshippers to service. The church is an architectural monument of national significance.

15. Bērze Graveyard

The parents of the State President Kārlis Ulmanis, his foster-parents, and many relatives are buried in the old Bērze cemetery. It was his wish to be buried in this cemetery as well. Sadly, he was deported to Russia in 1942, where he passed away. As the site of his grave was never found, in the early 90-ies a memorial in his honour was erected in Bērze Graveyard. Allegedly, it is the site, which Kārlis Ulmanis once had selected as his last resting place.

16. Bērze Water Mill

The water mill is a significant monument of technology and one of the very few still operating water mills in Latvia. Using water as its power source, the water mill employs grain processing techniques, over 100 years old, to grind grains and produce grits and pearl-barley.

17. Vegetable Farm “Saliņas”

At least 60 different sorts of tomatoes, sweet peppers, hot peppers, unusual cucumbers, physalises, melons, including kiwano and momordica are but a fraction of what you can discover and buy at the farm managed by the Otikovi family. All the produce is suitable for green thinkers thanks to chemical-free farming. Visitors can go on a tour of the farm, seek advice or buy vegetables.

This extraordinary garden with varied flower, vegetable and herb collections, a grapevine alley and a small artificial bog in “Lejnieki” is situated on the bank of the Bērze River. The garden is decorated with wooden sculptures and a big pyramid made by the host. In turn, the hostess is one of the most industrious mitten knitters in Latvia. Her collection boasts more than 170 hand-made pairs of mittens.

Let's go outdoors!

To relax from everyday stress, go to the western part of the County, where you will find the legendary Lake Zebrus. Here, the travellers will discover a landscape not characteristic to Zemgale – rolling hills and winding roads.

19. Lake Zebrus

Lake Zebrus is the largest and most beautiful lake in the county. It is managed by JSC “Latvia’s State Forests”. Fish stock is replenished on an annual basis, which guarantees a good catch. Zebrus Lake is one of the few lakes which is inhabited by pike-perch. The recreational centre “Niedras” is a popular recreational site by the lake. The walking paths and bicycle routes help you explore the beauty of nature and historical and cultural heritage.

20. Ezerlūķi Castle Mound

The castle mound, 30 m in height, is situated on the eastern bank of Lake Zebrus. An ancient Latvian castle was once built on this hillock. Legend has it that once there was a long, rocky sandbank, called Gods’ or Priests’ Road, that led across the lake from the Elku Hill to Ezerlūķi Castle.

21. Elku Hill of Zebrene

The nearly 20 m high hillock, covered in trees, between Lake Zebrus and Lake Svête, is an ancient site of worship and sacrifice dedicated to ancient Zemgalian gods. Elku Hill used to be a Latvian sanctuary – the central cult site of Zemgalians.

22. Lake Svête

Surrounded by forests, this lake is a perfect recreational site for those who enjoy peace and quiet and untouched nature. It is located nearby Lake Zebrus, separated from it by Elku Hill and the Svête Bog 0.5 km in width. In ancient times the lakes were connected.

23. Krievkalni Hill

The long wall of Krievkalni Hill, covered with woods, is a unique form of terrain.

A vast panoramic view of Zemgale forests opens from the highest point of Krievkalni, elevated 149 m above sea level. The recreational site of Krievkalni can be accessed by a footpath.

24. Pokaiņi Forest

Pokaiņi Forest is the most mysterious place in Latvia, also called “the X-files” of Latvia. The stone rivers, stone piles, walls and peculiar solitary stones have given rise to fantastic explanations and contradictory assumptions. One of the viewpoints is that this place was once an ancient sacred place. Pokaiņi is viewed as a place with a very strong energetic field, which is why lots of people come to Pokaiņi in hope of recovering their health. This site is also appealing with its tranquillity, variable terrain and scenic beauty, criss-crossed with long footpaths, which connect the main attractions.

Step into History!

The complex history of Latvia is carved in monuments, immortalized in memorial sites and conserved in the private collections of ancient objects. Let's visit these sites and read the message they convey!

26. Īle National Partisans' Bunker

The renovated Partisans' Bunker is not only a tribute to the national partisans, but also a fascinating place of interest, which reveals another page of the tragic Latvian history.

The largest partisans' bunker in the Baltic States was built in 1948 in the Īle forests by the united Latvian-Lithuanian group of national partisans to continue resistance fighting against Soviet rule. On March 17, 1949, the partisans who occupied the bunker at the time fought their last battle against the KGB army of 760 men. 15 partisans were killed and 9 were captured along with their supporters and deported to Siberia. The bunker has been restored exactly as it was prior to the bombing. The White Cross and memorial objects were erected next to the bunker.

27. Antique collection at "Liči"

28. Memorial place in Kambari

This memorial site was established at the very centre of the vast Zemgale plains nearby the former farm “Kambari”. The battles fought here in January 1945 have gone down in history with a high number of fatalities on both sides. It is a tragic site where Latvians had to fight against other Latvians. Here more than 2,000 young Latvian males lost their lives as pointless “cannon fodder” after having been drafted illegally to the Red Army from Vidzeme and Latgale. In the Soviet times, a monument was erected on this site.

29. Annenieki Evangelic Lutheran Church

In 1711, a wooden church was built on the site where after the Great Plague the inhabitants of the nearby area were buried. The present church was built in the mid-18th century. During the Soviet era the church was destroyed and demolished. In 1990, the steeple of the tower was renovated and adorned with a gilded rooster, cross and ball.
